2003-2007 Mitsubishi Evolution Downpipe



The installation of the downpipe is straight forward. This install instruction is a brief run down on how to install QTP Evolution downpipe.

Removing Factory Equipment

Remove factory cross bars from chassis then remove the downpipe.

Installing Downpipe

Bolt down pipe to O2 housing and to the factory cat. Install the passenger side hanger bushing only. Reinstall front cross bar only.

Installing QTEC

Take off block off plate and install the valve as shown in picture. Tighten bolts. Connect intermediate wire and route into car via the front driver side drain plug.



Remove side plastic panels and pull intermediate wire up.

Drill a 1/2" hole and mount switch. Tap for power and ground from the fuse box.



Double check everything is tight and start the car. Inspect for leaks retighten if necessary.
